“ROCHEMP2020: training for cultural heritage experts”

Selection of participants to the training course in the framework of the ROCHEMP Project

A selection by evaluation of qualifications for the admission to intensive training course for cultural heritage experts is open. The training course, to be held in Yerevan (Armenia) will be activated by "ROCHEMP - Regional Office for Cultural Heritage Enhancement, Management and Protection" Project, developed by the University of Bologna (Italy) and the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport of the Republic of Armenia, with the support of AICS (Italian Agency for Cooperation Development), with the support of NUACA - National University of Architecture and Construction of Armenia. The course is **free of charge for the selected candidates**.

The course is based on theoretical and practical learning activities and composed by **lectures, individual study** and **laboratory practice**. The course units are the following:

- 1- ***“Quality assessment and methodological drafting of conservation projects”***, composed by 3 learning modules (*Theoretical bases; Tools for the draft of the conservation project; Draft of technical tools for conservation project*) - 40 hours.
- 2- ***“Technical drawing for architectural restoration works and for decorated surfaces in architecture”***, composed by 4 learning modules (*Presentation of case study; Survey of the state of conservation; The conservation project; Planning of conservation projects*) - 72 hours.
- 3- ***“Techniques for the evaluation of architectural restoration works and for decorated surfaces in architecture”***, composed by 3 learning modules (*Tools for the preparation of estimated metric calculation; Tools for building site management; Preparation of the estimative metric calculation*) - 60 hours.
- 4- ***“Methods and procedures for digital cultural heritage and for the valorisation of cultural heritage for tourism purposes”***, composed by 3 modules (*Introduction to Digital Cultural Heritage; Case studies, models and methodologies of Digital Heritage; Management and enhancement of cultural heritage*) - 60 hours.

The courses will be provided **in English**.

For the selected candidates, attendance to the training course will be **mandatory for 75% of the total amount of hours of each unit** and presence to the lectures will be assessed by signing of attendance. At the end of the training course, **certification of attendance** will be released from the ROCHEMP Center to all the participants, proving details on the training path.

The Project covers all the costs related to the teaching activities. No other type of refund is provided to the participants. The candidates admitted to the training courses will also participate in a so-called “training on-the-job” experience, a practical activity on a selected case study, which will be held in

May and June. **The expenses for travel and stay for the on-site activities will be covered by the ROCHEMP Project.**

Requested qualification to access the program is a **Master Degree** in:

- cultural heritage studies
- digital technologies for cultural heritage
- management and economic studies for cultural heritage
- monuments and architectural heritage
- conservation and restoration of cultural heritage
- archaeology
- art history
- museology
- cultural anthropology
- any other subject related to cultural heritage studies.

The candidate must be **fluent in written and spoken English** (certification could be provided and will be evaluated). The possession of the requirements will be verified by evaluating the submitted Curriculum Vitae proving participation in past activities related to management, conservation and enhancement of cultural heritage.

The candidates must present:

- copy of personal document (passport, ID card,...)
- professional curriculum vitae,
- motivational letter with description of the main activities and experiences gained in management, conservation or/and enhancement and communication of cultural heritage.

The required documents (see check-list) must be provided in digital, preferable in English, **no later than 8th February 2020 - 12 pm.**

The submitted applications will be evaluated by a Scientific Commission, composing a merit ranking. All the qualified candidates within the first **30 positions** will be considered as **selected**. The selected candidates will be required to present digital copies of the qualifications and training certificates as indicated in the CV (preferably certified translations in English or Armenian or Italian). The candidates placed from position 31 to position 45 will be considered as "eligible unselected candidates" and may take over in the event of renunciations (in order of ranking).

The access to the training courses will be notified to the admitted candidates by email, starting from 10th February 2020.

No communications will be provided by telephone or in person.

Confirmations of participation by the participants must be received by the ROCHEMP Center, to the email info@rochemp.org, no later than 14th February 2020 - 12 am.
